Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will know, school closes for the Christmas break at <u>3pm on Thursday 17th December</u> and schools have been asked to put arrangements in place, should a member of our school community begin to display covid-19 symptoms in the 48 hours after school has closed.

Please read this carefully and follow the guidance so that we can help reduce the spread of the virus.

It is vital that you have the school app downloaded and working, as we will use this to contact you should there be a need for your child to self-isolate.

Please keep checking the app for the first 6 days of the holiday (up to and including the 23rd December). The Government anticipates that after 6 days, we will not need to contact you regarding self-isolation as any school contact of those that have tested positive will have been traced before then.

During the holidays, if you child has any of the following symptoms:

- A high temperature
- A new continuous cough
- A loss of taste or smell

You must take them for a Covid Test. If they test positive and their symptoms start before 3pm on Saturday 19th December, **you MUST inform the school via the parent app. or by email.** Please note that the school answer machine will not be being checked.

This is so that we can inform the relevant authorities and inform parents if any others need to self-isolate.

Thank you to you all for your support over what has been an extremely challenging term.
